Processing Information

This collection consists of materials formerly classed as MS Vault Shelves Sala, Ms Vault Sala, Uncat MS Vault 801, and Uncat Ms Vault File. In 2013, the collection received a baseline level of processing, including partial rehousing and minimal organization. The collection was reclassified under one call number, materials were organized by acquisition, and containers were renumbered in a single sequence. Most folder titles and folder notes were adapted from card catalog descriptions; some were assigned by Library staff. Chronological arrangement within groups of correspondence was retained, and card catalog see references from names of correspondents were adapted as subseries notes. Some names of correspondents were updated to conform to Library of Congress name authorities. Folder titles were not verified against contents.

George Augustus Sala (1828-1895)

English journalist; contributed to the *Daily Telegraph* and other serials; and published collections of his articles. Sala was a son of singer and actress Henrietta Catherina Florentina Simon Sala (1789?-1860). He married Harriet Elizabeth Hollingsworth Sala (died 1885) in 1859, and he married Bessie Stannard Sala in 1890.

Ralph Straus (1882-1950)

English author and journalist. Author of *Sala: the Portrait of an Eminent Victorian* (London: Constable, [1942]).

Scope and Contents

The George Augustus Sala Collection consists of papers accumulated by Ralph Straus in writing his biography of Sala; and autograph manuscript correspondence and writings by Sala acquired by the Library from other sources. Papers of Straus consist of autograph letters, signed, to and from Sala, members of his family, and others; autograph manuscript writings and notes by Sala; clippings of articles by and about Sala; photographs, engraved portraits, and printed caricatures of Sala; and autograph manuscript notes and correspondence of Straus.

Organized into two series: I. Ralph Straus Papers Relating to George Augustus Sala, 1828-1942. II. Materials from Other Sources, 1855-1899.

Series I: Ralph Straus Papers Relating to George Augustus Sala, 1841-1942

Correspondence consists of autograph letters, signed, from and to George Augustus Sala; Harriet Elizabeth Hollingsworth Sala; and Bessie Stannard Sala; and to Henrietta Catherina Florentina Simon Sala. Also present are typed transcripts of letters from George Augustus Sala, and third-party autograph letters, signed, concerning Sala. Writings of George Augustus Sala contains autograph manuscript drafts and clippings of articles and stories; autograph manuscript notes and fragments; and a disbound copy of Sala's autobiography, *The Life and Adventures of George Augustus Sala* (London: Cassell, 1895). Other Papers of George Augustus Sala contain additional writings fragments, family papers, and ephemera. Other Papers of Ralph Straus contains autograph manuscript notes, correspondence, and research materials. Original folders have been retained; additional fragments of notes by Straus, apparently concerning Sala, are affixed to some.

Organized into four subseries: Correspondence, arranged by names of Sala and his family, and subarranged chronologically within each name; Writings by George Augustus Sala, arranged alphabetically by work title; Other Papers of George Augustus Sala, arranged alphabetically by folder title; and Other Papers of Ralph Straus, arranged alphabetically by folder title.
